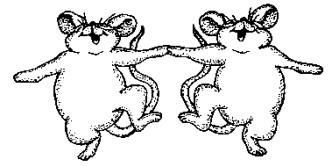




# The Puget Sound Earthdog Club Presents an AKC Earthdog Judges' Seminar
